Q4 I'm going to tell you a little bit more about eviction in your District. Eviction court proceedings are typically skewed to favor landlords, but securing tenants' right to counsel can help level this imbalance. When tenants have legal representation, they are twice as likely to remain housed. Securing legal representation for those facing eviction is a critical step Delaware legislators can take to stop evictions and keep people in their homes during the pandemic and beyond. New York City passed a similar law-and because of that law, 86 percent of tenants who had representation were able to remain in their homes.
