Renters in Delaware are often faced with an eviction notice that threatens their homes, their families, and their well-being. Even more often, the people facing eviction must navigate that legal hurdle by themselves. In Delaware, **86% of landlords** have legal representation in court eviction proceedings, but only **2% of renters** have representation.

## New Castle Survey Results

**Q1** Do you approve or disapprove of President Joe Biden's job performance?

**Q7** Some states have passed legislation that allows state Medicaid insurance to cover the cost of an abortion. Advocates have said that the typical cost of an abortion is \$500, and many pregnant people have additional expenses like childcare, transportation, and missed pay. For low-income people and those living paycheck-to-paycheck, this can make access to abortion difficult, if not impossible. Opponents of this legislation have argued that taxpayer dollars should not pay for abortion. Do you think the General Assembly should pass legislation to allow state Medicaid insurance to cover the cost of an abortion, or not?
