Q7 Some states have passed legislation that allows state Medicaid insurance to cover the cost of an abortion. Advocates have said that the typical cost of an abortion is \$500, and many pregnant people have additional expenses like childcare, transportation, and missed pay. For low-income people and those living paycheck-to-paycheck, this can make access to abortion difficult, if not impossible. Opponents of this legislation have argued that taxpayer dollars should not pay for abortion.
