No City of Newark police officer may stop a person, who while abroad or in a place from which the public is not excluded is taking photographs of railroad equipment or property or preparing to take photographs of railroad equipment or property to demand the person's name and address, or proof of identification, unless the officer has reasonable ground to suspect the person is committing, has committed or is about to commit a crime. Before stopping the person, the officer must have an articulable basis for the suspicion that is based on something other than the fact that the person has photographic equipment near train tracks or other railroad property or otherwise appears to be taking or preparing photographs of railroad equipment or railroad property.
